

Provide 100% free of charge medical facilities to children from across the country

Initiated by the Sri Lanka College of Paediatricians and a few concerned citizens of Sri Lanka, the Little Hearts project has been set up to raise funds for the construction of a Cardiac and Critical Care Complex at the Lady Ridgeway Hospital in Colombo. This will create the ability to provide 100% free-of-charge medical treatment for around 10,000 children every year and prevent 1,500 unnecessary deaths due to cardiac and critical illnesses.

The Lady Ridgeway Hospital for Children (LRH) is a tertiary care children's hospital in Colombo, Sri Lanka. With a bed-strength of over 900 and nearly 3,000 patients visiting for outpatient care daily, all services are provided free of charge in keeping with the free state healthcare policy of the Sri Lankan government. LRH is the only tertiary care referral centre for children with congenital heart disease (CHD) in the country at present.

However, the Children's Heart Centre's capacity is now capped and the hospital wing can no longer expand. It can treat only up to 1,700 children with CHD annually, while the number of children in need of treatment is far greater. It is estimated that there are over 3,000 children born with CHD in Sri Lanka per year. Consequently, every year over 40% of these children do not have appropriate access to the treatment they desperately need.



3,000 Children are born in Need of Treatment

LRH's growing waitlists testify to the hospital's current inability to cope with the number of critically ill children in need of its services. With an inventory of check them into private institutions 11 medical intensive care unit (ICU) beds, where intensive care costs anywhere the hospital can currently accommodate from LKR 100,000 – 500,000 per day! only 40% of the total of its medical requests, leaving 60% of critically ill children at risk.

incapable of paying the premium fees for private hospitals or foreign institutions, so ones in general wards, or in severe cases, all of their hopes lie with government institutions that provide fully-subsidised treatments.

The hospital's current infrastructure forces even the children in need of urgent surgery into home care. This not only greatly increases the risk of succumbing to the illness, but it also glues the parents by their child's side, letting all other spheres of their lives slip away.

Parents from all

It is not rare that these mothers and fathers would lose jobs, fall into unrepayable debt and even unknowingly neglect their other children. Waiting for treatment, therefore, not only lessens a child's chance of successful recovery, but it also tends to leave grave consequences on their families.

The construction of the LRH's Cardiac and Critical Care Complex will ensure that every critically ill child in Sri Lanka has immediate access to quality care.

This new ten story building will introduce four state-of-the-art cardiac operating theatres, increase the number of cardiac ICU beds from 18 to 40, include over 100 medical and neonatal intensive care beds, as well as the areas for advanced cardiac investigations and staff training facilities to provide optimum care for these children.

The cost of the project is estimated to be

approximately 2 billion rupees, and it is estimated that the new LRH wing will save more than 200,000 critically ill children in Sri Lanka over the next 20 years. Therefore, with a total fund of LKR 2 billion, the amount we would invest in saving each life would be LKR 10,000. This investment can be viewed as the insurance for all of our children. It will help secure facilities that will finally put an end to waitlist nightmares and provide immediate critical care to all the children in



Managing Diabetes

Sri Lanka's conventional diet consist mainly of starch based food items and this is one of the biggest challenges that diabetes patients in our country face in their attempt to manage their blood sugar levels to stay healthy. A balanced diet is an essential ingredient to leading a healthy lifestyle as a diabetes patient. Starch and sugar supplies energy required for the body to function. While we are mostly used to a diet of 3 main meals in large portions, it is advisable to spread out the consumption into three main meals with snacks in between.

Unsaturated Fat & Food to Avoid

While the use of oil containing unsaturated fat, such as sunflower oil, sesame oil, olive oil and soy oil is deemed healthy, it is better to avoid over consumption of food prepared even with the use of these types of cooking oil. Recent findings indicate that fish contain healthy unsaturated fat and medical experts recommend the consumption of fish two or three times a week.

However, minimizing the usage of oil is a healthy lifestyle option that diabetes patients can adopt. While fatty acids and saturated fat supply energy, excessive intake of these dietary essentials can lead to heart disease, as the excess fat gets stored in fat cells and causes weight gain as well as high levels of cholesterol and triglycerides to be present in our blood. Cholesterol and triglycerides are types of lipid (types of fat) present in our blood, a high percentage of which can lead to heart disease.

Avoiding certain types of food and beverages will help you maintain your health and wellbeing. Sugar, sweets and sweetened food, sweetmeats, sugar biscuits, soft drinks containing sugar, ice cream and alcohol are best avoided.

Healthy food for diabetes patients

Our ancestors lived long and healthy lives as a result of their active ways of living as well as the healthy locally sourced food that they consumed. Even today, we can benefit from this ancient wisdom to stay healthy.

Sri Lanka is blessed with various types of edible greens that the local cuisine has adopted in the form of 'Mallum' or stir fried green leaves. Tender leaves of pumpkin, passion fruit as well as other edible leaves such as 'thebu', drumstick (Moringa Oleifera), 'ranawara' and 'sarana' are good examples of life giving local food sources.

In addition, you could include various types of lentils, herbal drinks and herb infused curries to your diet to achieve a balanced food pattern.

Fortified with vitamins, minerals and essential fibre, both vegetables and fruit infuse a healthy balance to your diet. These food items will boost your immunity, assist you to maintain strong eyesight and to add a healthy glow to your complexion.

Medication for Diabetes patients

Diabetes patients first received insulin to battle blood sugar levels in 1922 but it was medicinally administered only in the year 1939 in the United States.

Today, millions of diabetes patients use insulin to control their blood sugar levels. Initially, (until 1980s) animal insulin derived from cows and pigs were used to treat

diabetes patients. However, these have now been replaced by human insulin. A DNA technology developed by scientists, called Recombinant DNA, has made it possible to develop human insulin in laboratories. While animal insulin is still available, its usage has diminished over the years.

Type 1 diabetes patients require daily administration of insulin as their bodies do not produce insulin naturally. However, when a patient regularly receives insulin shots, it is important for that patient to keep track of his or her blood sugar levels in order to avoid hypoglycemia (an excessive drop in blood sugar levels). Symptoms of hypoglycemia include hunger, behavioural changes, nausea, fatigue, trembling and excessive sweating.

Diabetic Retinopathy

Diabetic Retinopathy is an illness associated with diabetes that patients should be aware of as this condition could cause loss of vision. When high blood sugar levels damage blood vessels in the light sensitive tissue in the retina, the effects can lead to loss of vision.

Diabetic Maculopathy is another condition that can damage your vision. The macula assists patients with central vision and when the macula sustains damage as a result of Diabetic Macular Oedema, it could cause blood vessels nearby to leak fluid onto the macula.

While laser treatment procedure is used to treat eye damage caused by Diabetic Retinopathy and Diabetic Maculopathy, medical practitioners advice diabetic patients to consult an Ophthalmologist (an eye surgeon) once a year to prevent the onset of these conditions.






Together with their parents, 80 shortlisted young participants attended the Awards Ceremony for a fun evening of awards and celebrations.
